Curriculum Implementation

Our curriculum is carefully planned to combine knowledge, skills and curriculum threads to produce a purposeful and exciting learning journey for each child. Teaching and learning opportunities have been thoughtfully mapped out in our long-term plans to enable pupils to develop the necessary knowledge and skills to contribute successfully in the modern world. Pupils revisit, apply and deepen their prior learning within and across subject areas. Teachers use these long-term plans to produce the medium term plans outlining the sequences of learning for each unit, and these inform the detailed daily and weekly plans which are responsive to the needs of all learners including those with SEND, high and low attainers and EAL.

The plans also highlight the curriculum intent, identify the curriculum drivers and also show the links to prior and future learning. Key vocabulary and key facts are also mapped across our curriculum, with opportunities to revisit and embed learnt vocabulary are planned for. Whenever possible, visitors are regularly invited into our schools and educational and residential visits are carefully chosen to enrich our curriculum.

Our pupils have access to a wide range of opportunities, which promote personal safety and pupil voice with all children being actively involved in whole school decision making through the School Council, Pupil Parliament and many positions of responsibility including Head Boy and Girls, Prefects and House Captains.
